

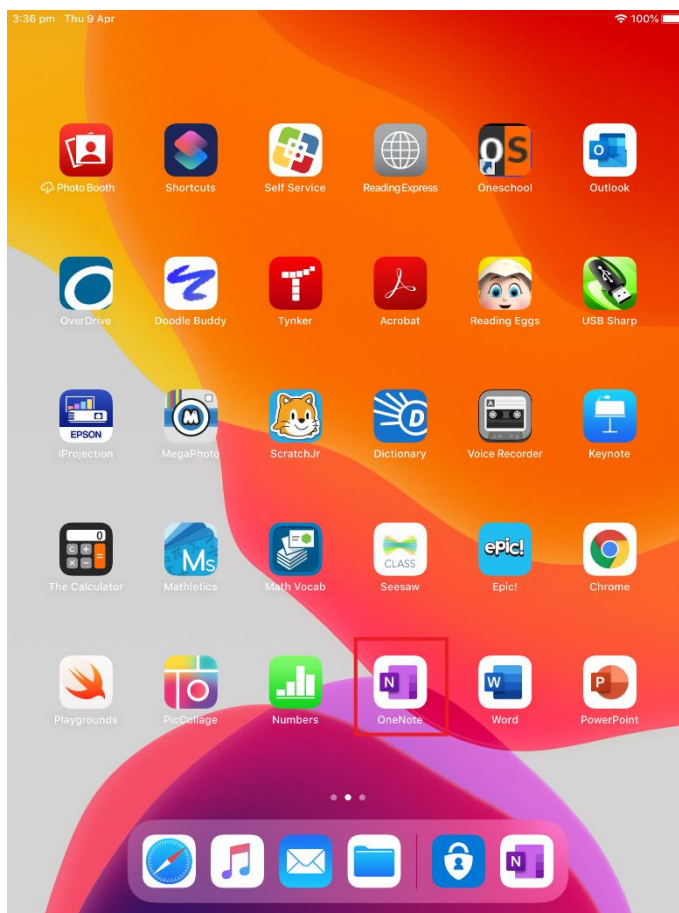

1. Please ensure you have the following apps installed on your device before you continue. Clicking on the link below will direct you to the App store, alternatively you can scan the QR code

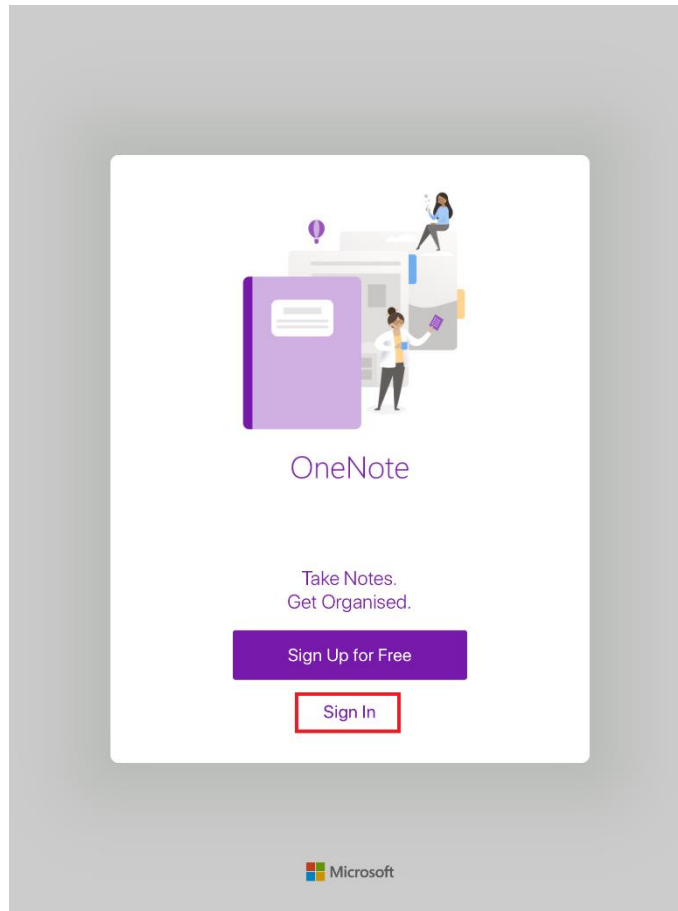

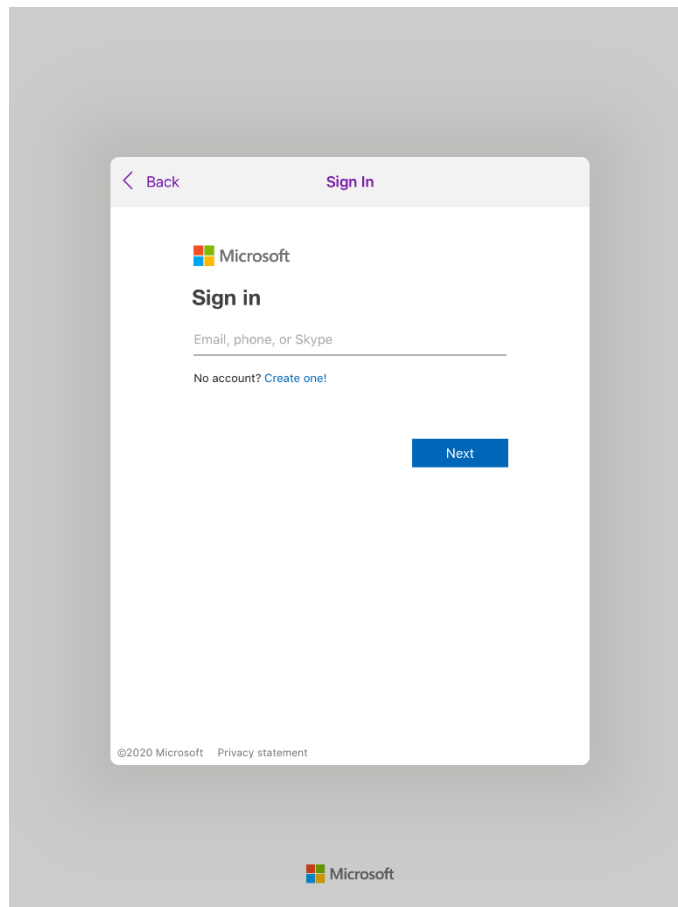
2. Open the OneNote app on your IOS device.



3. Once the OneNote App has opened, select "Sign In".




4. Enter your full EQ email address (e.g. jsmith123@eq.edu.au) select "Next".

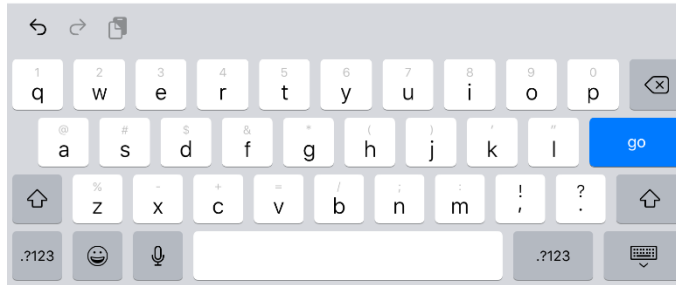


5. You will be redirected to the Department of Education's Managed Internet Service Sign in page.

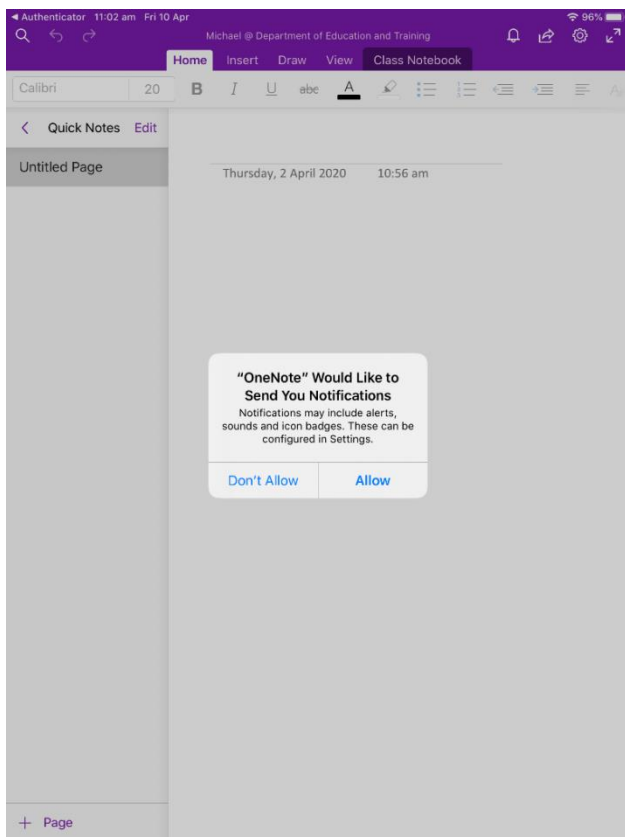
- Log in by:

 - Clicking on 'Sign in'



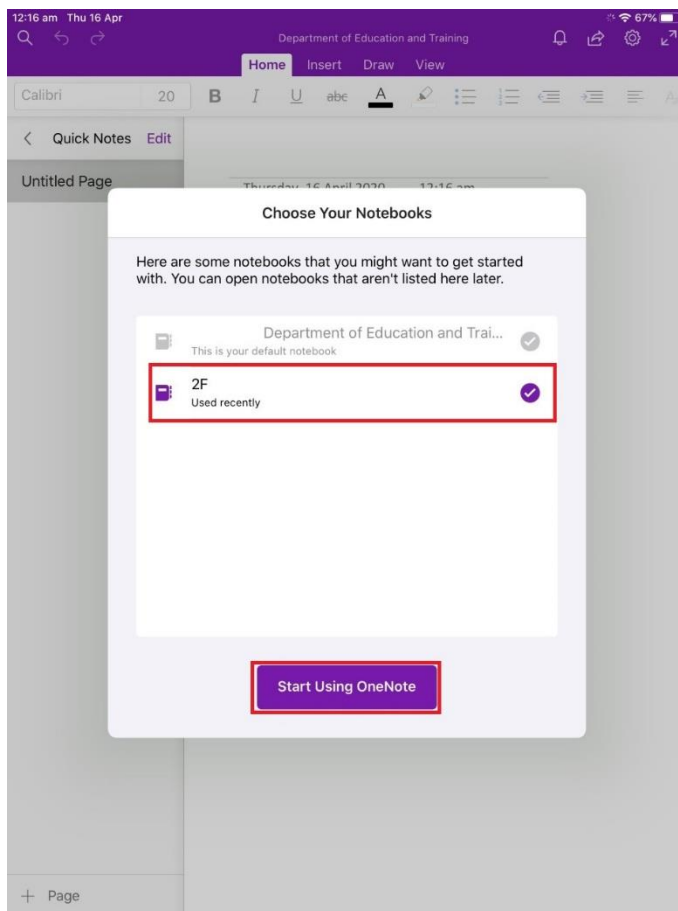

7. A pop-up will appear on screen "Choose your notebooks" select any notebook's that you would like to open, then select "Start using OneNote".





$a^2 + b^2 = c^2$

Statement: The square of the hypotenuse (the side opposite the right angle) is equal to the sum of the squares of the other two sides.

- **Only applies to the right angled triangles.**
- Can be used to find the length of the third side of a right angled triangle given the other two sides.
